**THE INTERLAKEN INN INTRODUCES WIRELESS INTERNET**

**IN THE FOOTHILLS OF THE BERKSHIRES**

Although rapidly becoming a staple for center city hotels, wireless Internet service is available at few boutique and mid-sized resorts located outside major metropolitan areas. The Interlaken Inn Resort of Litchfield County, Connecticut, which is nestled in the foothills of The Berkshires, however, has installed wireless Internet service throughout the 81-guestroom resort. Business and leisure guests visiting the recently-renovated property can now sit at the pool and check email, practice their golf swing on the Inn's private executive golf school and reference their hand-held, or lounge on the balcony of their guestroom and engage in Web-based chat with the family at home or their colleagues at the office. Use of the service is \$9.95 per day.

"We cater to a diverse population of travelers who have requested the same service 100 miles from New York City that they enjoy in Manhattan or their city of origin," stated Kevin Bousquet, general manager and equity partner of The Interlaken Inn Resort. "They love the ability to sit poolside with their laptop linked by network card to a Web-enabled PDA or NEXTEL network device, and stay in touch in an unusually casual setting."

The Interlaken has just installed the wireless technology -- a T1 Digital Private Line, which is DS-1 technology and a dedicated, point-to-point digital transport pipeline designed for full-duplex transmission of data, voice and video at 1.544 Mbps. Because transmission is digital from end to end, the signal is clean and pure -- free of cross talk, amplified noise or distortion. Unlike switched services that share resources, T1 service guarantees that the full bandwidth is available for guest's use. Guests at the Inn experience breathtaking data transfer speeds for browsing the Internet, downloading files and email, and accessing their home-office LANs and Intranets.

The Interlaken Inn Resort ([www.InterlakenInn.com](http://www.InterlakenInn.com)) is located in the foothills of the Berkshires, in historic Litchfield County, Connecticut. The property is situated between two picturesque lakes. It offers 80 first-class guestrooms and the award-winning Morgan's Restaurant, serving New American cuisine. The Inn features extensive resort, recreation and fitness facilities. It is located adjacent to Hotchkiss Golf Course, which is recognized as one of Connecticut's most scenic and challenging courses, and near Route 7, Connecticut's renowned antique route.
